POPI Program Information

History

The NIH Campus East Child Care Center is operated by Parents of Preschoolers, Inc. POPI is a non-profit corporation and provides childcare for children 6 weeks to 5 years. POPI is licensed by the Maryland State Department of Education Office of Child Care (MSDE) and is currently seeking accreditation through the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC).

Program

POPI offers mixed-age classrooms which provide a more varied approach to learning. Each child can be taught or grouped for play with other children at his or her level, regardless of age. The benefits of mixed-age groups are many; including: a richer learning environment where children can learn from one another, greater communication skills, fewer transitions, bonding; not only between caregiver and child but also between caregiver and that child's family.

Hours of Operation

POPI is open Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Curriculum

POPI implements the Objectives for Development & Learning using the Creative Curriculum for Infants, Toddlers & Twos ® and the Creative Curriculum for Preschool ®.

Nutrition

POPI provides the children with breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack using the USDA regulated Child and Adult Care food Program (CACFP).

Ratios

POPI strives to meet and exceed MSDE regulated child to adult ratios by staffing classrooms with an extra staff person to assist teachers during active times of the day.

At POPI we believe children learn through play and hands-on experiences. Our highly qualified teachers and administrative staff work with families to create a safe and inviting learning environment that fosters socio-emotional, language, physical, and cognitive development.
