## Project Update

*Construction Began summer 2009*

The week of May 17, 2010 The Maryland Department of Transportation's State Highway Administration (SHA) will begin overnight work on the one mile long resurfacing project along both directions of MD 187 in Montgomery County.

The overnight work includes milling and grinding of the existing pavement to prepare for final resurfacing. The work must be done at night to pose the least negative impact to traffic.

During the overnight work, residents and drivers can expect double lane closures along MD 187 overnight Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.

SHA will provide variable message signs, drums, and arrow boards to guide motorists through the work zone. SHA awarded the contract to M. Luis Construction, Co., Inc.

The \$2 million project includes grinding and resurfacing all lanes of MD 187 between Center Drive and North Brook Lane. Other work includes replacing inlets, cleaning pipes, upgrade existing sidewalks to ADA standards, pavement markings, curb and gutter replacement, installation and replacement of traffic loop detectors, and upgrade traffic signals to APS/CPS. Weather permitting, the project should be complete summer 2010.
