## Emergency and Fire:

Call Fire and Police

- On Main NIH Campus: Dial 911 from an office phone or 301-496-9911 from a cell phone
- Off Campus: Dial 9, then 911 from an office phone or 911 from a cell phone



## Occupation Injuries and Illnesses:

- Report all injuries and illnesses to Occupational Medical Service (OMS)
- Monday – Friday 7:30am to 5:00pm Building 10, Room 6C306 (301-496-4411)
- If OMS is closed, call the Clinical Center Operator at 301-496-1211 and ask them to page an OMS physician
