When setting up or updating your safety training account, it is important to note, fields marked with an asterisk are mandatory.

[Curser glides past the first and last name categories]

Input your NIH badge number in the format required.

[Curser moves to the badge number category format]

Include a working email address.

[Curser moves to the email address category. Email address populates the field]

[Curser moves to the Institute field drop down list]

Selecting the correct Institute is important for maintaining your records.

[Curser moves to the Job Function category drop down list]

The Job Function category indicates for what classes you will see reminders.

Use the drop down list to select a category.

[Curser clicks on the blue "I" button next to Job Function.] [Pop-up

window appears][Pop-up window closes]

Click on the blue "I" button to bring up a pop-up window which explains the Job Function categories.

[Curser moves to the scroll bar at My role at NIH]

The category "My Role at NIH" contains a list of roles. Pick the most accurate role for your work at NIH.

[Curser moves to the bottom of the page and hovers over "save

changes" button]

Once you are finished filling out or correcting your profile, click on the save changes button, to accept this information.
